- 1. 1 \$1,500 Scholarship Electrical Lineworker / Electrical Engineer
 - The applicant must attend an accredited electrical lineworker program or pursue a post-secondary education in the electrical engineering field to be eligible.
 - \$1,500 will be paid directly to the school at the beginning of the second semester or completion of the program.
 - The applicant must achieve a 2.5 GPA during the first semester and/or program and provide proof of enrollment in the second semester or provide certification of completion to receive the disbursement.
- 2. 4 \$1,000.00 Scholarships in any field of study
 - The applicant must pursue a post-secondary education in any field of study that leads to a degree, certification, or license to be eligible.
 - \$1,000 will be paid upon at least 12 hours enrollment directly to the school at the beginning of second semester.
 - The applicant must maintain a 2.5 GPA during the first semester and provide proof of enrollment in the second semester to receive the disbursement.
- 3. The applicant must be a senior graduating from an accredited high school or homeschooling program.
- 4. The applicant's parent(s) or guardian(s) must be a member(s) of Chariton Valley Electric Cooperative.
- 5. It will be the responsibility of the recipient to present the necessary documentation to Chariton Valley Electric to process payment of scholarship funds.
- 6. The student has a time limit of 12 months from date granted to claim the scholarship, or it will be forfeited.
- 7. The applicant must attend an accredited institution of higher learning including vocational school, technical school, junior college or university.
- 8. Chariton Valley Electric's Scholarship Selection Committee will make all the final decisions on recipients of the scholarships based upon the completion of the scholarship application, essay and high school transcripts.
- 9. The completed application, typed essay, and high school transcript must be received by *March 29, 2024*. All three are required to constitute application.
- 10. Applicants who are children or stepchildren of the Board of Directors or employees will not be eligible.
