SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM DETAILS

Scholarship Opportunities

- 1. \$1,500 Scholarship for Electrical Lineworker or Electrical Engineering Students
 - Applicants must enroll in an accredited electrical lineworker program or pursue a post-secondary education in the electrical engineering field.
 - The \$1,500 scholarship will be disbursed directly to the institution at the beginning of the second semester or upon completion of the program.
 - Recipients must achieve a minimum 2.5 GPA during the first semester/program and provide proof of second-semester enrollment or program completion certificate to receive the funds.
- 2. Four \$1,000 Scholarships for Any Field of Study
 - Applicants must pursue a post-secondary education in any field leading to a degree, certification or license.
 - The \$1,000 scholarship will be disbursed directly to the institution at the start of the second semester upon proof of at least 12 credit hours of enrollment.
 - Recipients must achieve a minimum 2.5 GPA during the first semester and provide proof of second-semester enrollment to receive the funds.

Eligibility Requirements

- 3. Applicants must be graduating seniors from an accredited high school or homeschooling program.
- 4. Applicant's parent(s) or guardian(s) must be active members of Chariton Valley Electric Cooperative.
- 5. Scholarships are limited to students attending accredited institutions of higher learning, including vocational schools, technical schools, junior colleges or universities.
- 6. Children or stepchildren of Chariton Valley Electric Cooperative employees or Board of Directors are not eligible.

Application Process

- 7. Applicants must submit:
 - A completed scholarship application.
 - A typed essay (topic to be provided on the application).
 - A high school transcript.
 - All materials must be received by March 31, 2025. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Disbursement & Additional Terms

- 8. Recipients are responsible for providing Chariton Valley Electric Cooperative with the necessary documentation for scholarship disbursement.
- 9. Scholarships must be claimed within 12 months of being awarded. Unclaimed scholarships will be forfeited.
- 10. The Scholarship Selection Committee will review all applications and make final decisions based on submitted materials.
